Instructions for Project GO Applicants

1. Before you start filling in the application form, talk to the Project GO coordinator Conny Hauf (chauf@tamu.edu).
 - a. Let the Project GO coordinator know which language you are interested in and what your language background is. Ensure that your interests meet the eligibility criteria (found at the Project GO link on <http://corps.tamu.edu/global/>). Be prepared to discuss to which country or region you would like to travel.
 - b. Discuss with her your program options which include language programs offered through Texas A&M University as well as language programs offered by other Project GO institutions.
 - c. Discuss with her your statement of purpose and any related questions.
2. Make an appointment with the Study Abroad Programs Office (SAPO) to discuss Project GO program options. The program needs to be an intensive language program, eight to ten weeks long.
3. Project GO Application Instructions
 - a. **COMPLETE THE TAMU PROJECT GO APPLICATION ONLY, NOT ANY OTHER VERSION. You can download the application from the following website: <http://corps.tamu.edu/projectgo/>. You can also send an e-mail to Project GO coordinator at chauf@tamu.edu to receive an electronic copy of the application form.**
 - b. Complete the biographical information section and be sure to answer all yes/no questions.
 - c. Complete the study abroad program section with the information obtained during your consultation with a study abroad advisor (**program dates, program name, courses to be taken**).
 - d. Have the study abroad advisor print and sign their name on your Project GO application so that the Project GO coordinator and you will know whom to approach for follow-up questions. Signatures from the study abroad advisor will be waived for non-Texas A&M ROTC students applying for a Texas A&M Project GO scholarship.
 - e. Fill in your foreign language background, paying special attention to any college-level language experience. Provide information on foreign language experience during high school and on being a heritage speaker (= a language other than English spoken at home, but without formal classroom experience).
 - f. Closely read the terms of agreement and sign below to accept them.
 - g. Obtain a signature from your military science instructor or your ROTC commander.
 - h. Print out an unofficial grade transcript for the fall semester 2016.
 - i. Write and print out your statement of purpose. If you send your application materials via e-mail, please save your documents in pdf-format.
 - j. **TYPE and PRINT OUT** your application.
 - k. Scan your completed application form and e-mail it to Conny Hauf (chauf@tamu.edu). If you prefer to deliver your application in person, please email her for directions.
4. Your application will be considered when you have submitted the following documents by February 1, 2017:
 - a. Completed and typed TAMU Project GO Application including all necessary signatures
 - b. Unofficial grade transcript for the fall semester 2016
 - c. Statement of Purpose (saved in pdf format)

Students commissioning or graduating prior to the start of a Project GO study aboard program must delay both graduation and commissioning until after they return to the US. See your ROTC unit for advice.
